
Reading Readiness Activity



In order to learn to read, children must be able to distinguish small differences in the objects they are looking at---differences in size, shape, position, and color.

- A. Provide picture puzzles. Start with very simple puzzles for the younger children. The pieces should be large and easy to fit together.
- B. Play color detective. To sharpen the children's sense of color, ask them to point out all red objects in the room, all blue objects, and so on.
