Research indicates that the physical entrances to all of these chambers are possibly under the sea in various parts of the country. Let's take a look.

We all know that there is a "Bermuda Triangle" in the sea. At the Bermuda Triangle the compass does not point true north, and it changes as much as 20 degrees when a person is traveling near. It is 200 square miles off of the Atlantic coast. It has claimed over 1000 lives in 50 years. Since 1945, over 100



ships, boats and planes have vanished into the Bermuda Triangle and as of yet, has not been seen again. Strange glowing white water and green fog is seen from satellite.



If you find the Bermuda Triangle on a globe, and insert a bar from its location all the way through the center of the globe, it will come out on the other side of the globe at a place called "The Dead Sea", known as the "The Devil's Triangle." This place has very similar phenomena as does the Bermuda Triangle. It measures 36000 feet deep and the Bermuda Triangle measures 27000 feet deep.
